

How to access EBSCO eBooks from the Sheridan Library webpage

- Go to Sheridan Library webpage: <https://sheridan.edu.au/index.php/library>
- Select EBSCO EBOOKS link:

- Select EBSCO OA (Open Access) EBOOKS link:

- You will be directed to the EBSCO login page. Enter username and password.

- Limit your search to Full Text.
- For Example: If you are after law books you can select the Law category from the left-hand column.
- Or you can add the term Law* and it would retrieve all the law resources.

- You can download the book chapters
- Look out for the publisher's permission information, i.e.:
 - Publisher Permissions:
 - Print/E-mail/Save Unlimited Pages
 - Unlimited Copy/Paste
 - Unrestricted Download
 - eBook Availability:
 - Unlimited copies available, etc.
- What you can do with the retrieved eBook:
 - Download the APA 7th reference of book
 - Save pages of the book
 - Print pages of the book
 - Export information provided
 - Save the eBook in your online folder
- To get back to the homepage of eBooks, select the Result List.
