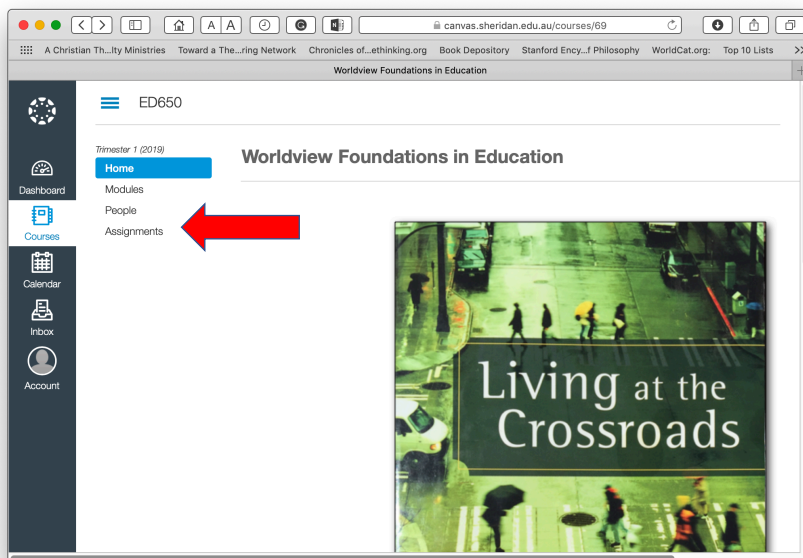


Submitting an assignment on Canvas as a Sheridan student

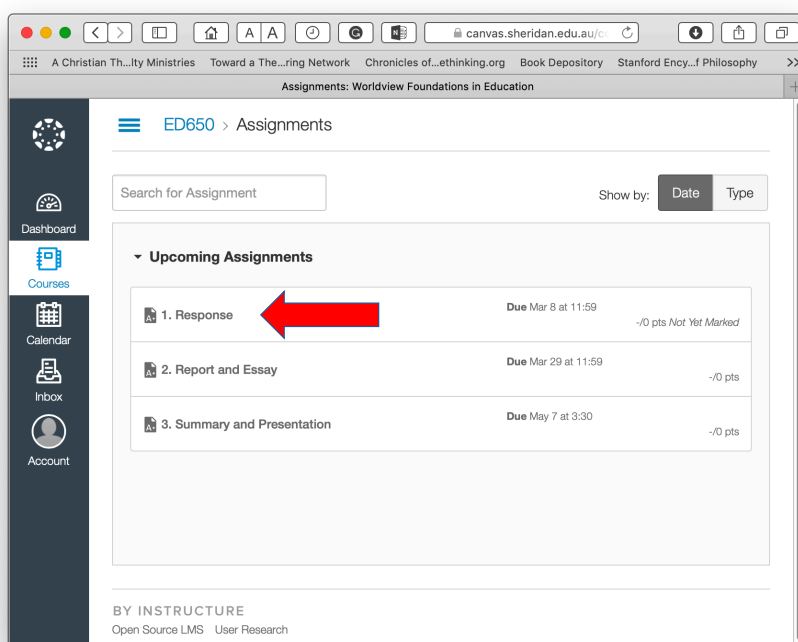
1. Before you submit, label your assignment with four essential details;

For example; **ED620 Assignment One Joe Bloggs 256352**

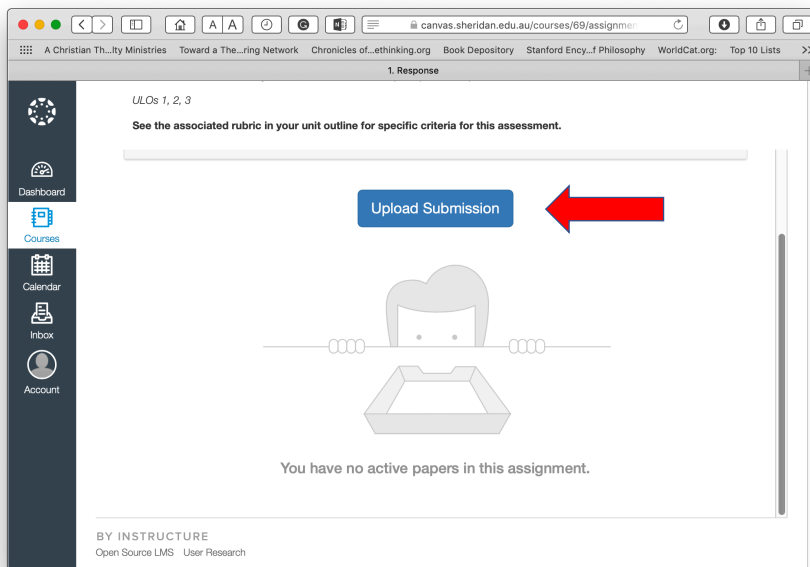
2. Log into Canvas and click on assignments within the correct unit



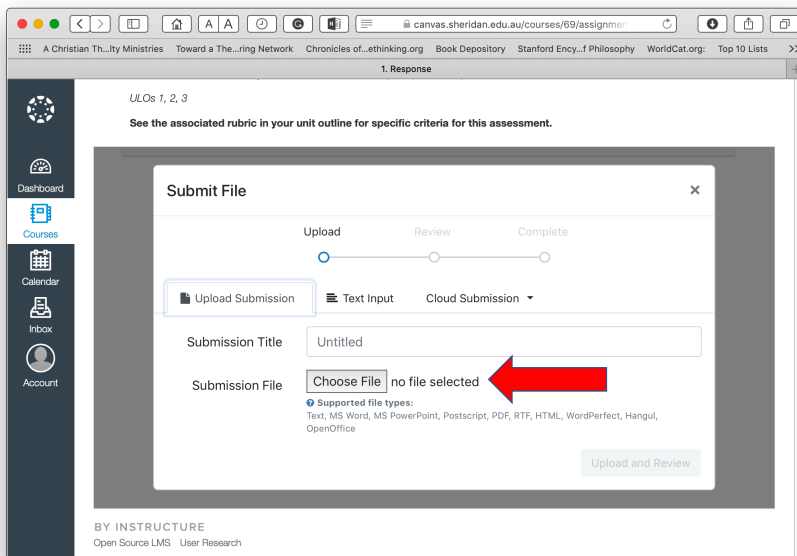
3. Click on the assignment you are submitting



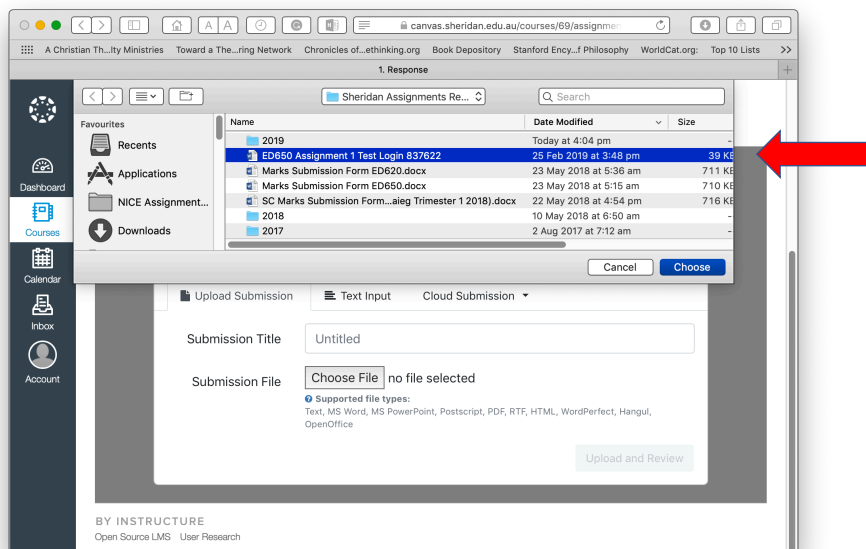
4. Click on the button 'Upload Submission'



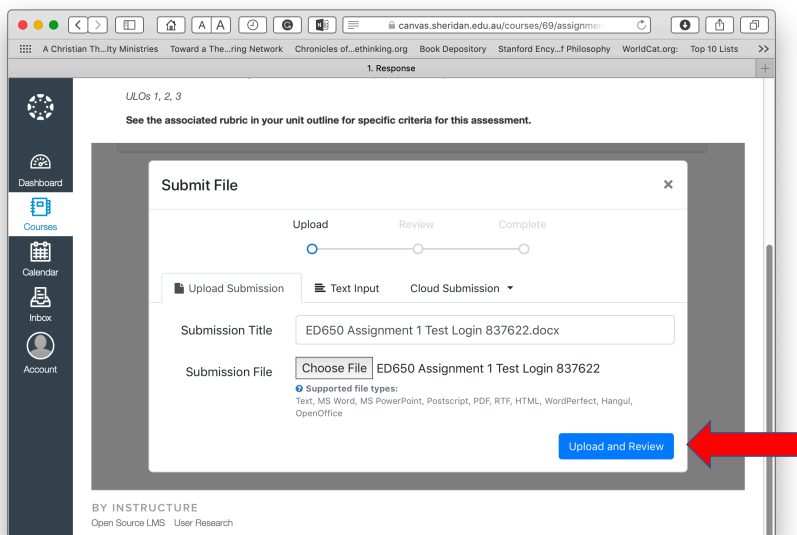
5. Click on the button 'Choose File'



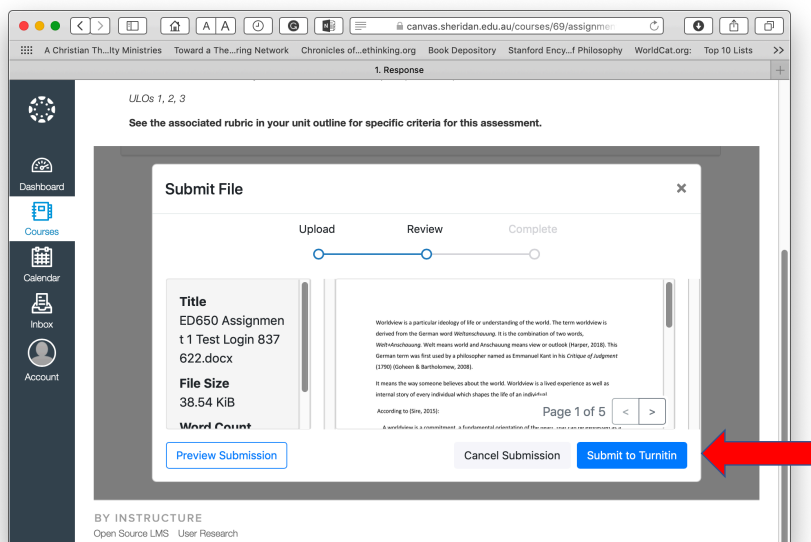
6. Locate the correctly titled assignment file you want to upload. Select the Click 'Choose'.




7. Click 'Upload and Review'.
